(1) <u>Graduate level</u> : Private regular students and research student of Saitama University (2) <u>Undergraduate level</u> : Private regular students of Saitama University</p> <p>2. Status of residence is or to be changed to "Student"</p> <p>3. Students should meet the required GPA in the previous academic year more than 2.3 on a 3.0 scale. Except newly enrolled students. (If it does not have Katakana name, please submit a photocopy of your bank card too)</p> <p>5. A certificate of Language Proficiency (English or Japanese)</p>
<b><u>Notification of selection results</u></b>	<p>Those who are finally decided to be recommended by the university will be notified by e-mail around October 15th (Friday).</p> <p>* Even if recommended by the university, you may be rejected by JASSO. Only those who has been accepted will be notified by email of the results of the JASSO examination in early November.</p>
